



PWW Volunteer Trips to Haiti: Trip Safety July 2018

Pure Water for the World has a deep appreciation for those individuals and groups who so generously offer their time, energy, and resources to join us on a volunteer trip to Haiti.

Traveler safety, as well as the safety of the PWW team, is of the utmost importance and travel decisions are taken very seriously and made with the highest level of caution and concern for the wellbeing of all.

Pure Water for the World works very closely with local staff when making volunteer trip and travel decisions. If the staff feels travel is unsafe at all, PWW will proactively cancel a trip.

The PWW Haiti staff closely monitors the locations volunteers are scheduled to visit during the trip and makes necessary adjustments to the schedule if there is any cause for concern. While PWW cannot ultimately guarantee the safety of travelers, all decisions made will put the security of the volunteers and team first and foremost.

PWW recommends purchasing trip insurance with airline tickets, in the event of any unforeseen changes to the trip. PWW also recommends that people traveling outside of the United States review the US Department of State Smart Traveler website (<https://step.state.gov/>).

In the end, your personal level of comfort must drive your decision to travel.
